GRANT ACTIVITY

The Scholar will be expected to teach two courses, and will be involved in the university's research activities. The Scholar will also be expected to give guest lectures at other Hungarian universities if invited. In addition to being a prestigious academic exchange program, the Fulbright Program is designed to expand and strengthen relationships between the people of the United States and citizens of other nations and to promote international understanding and cooperation. To support this mission, Fulbright Scholars will be asked to give public talks, mentor students, and otherwise engage with the host community, in addition to their primary activities.

LOCATION
