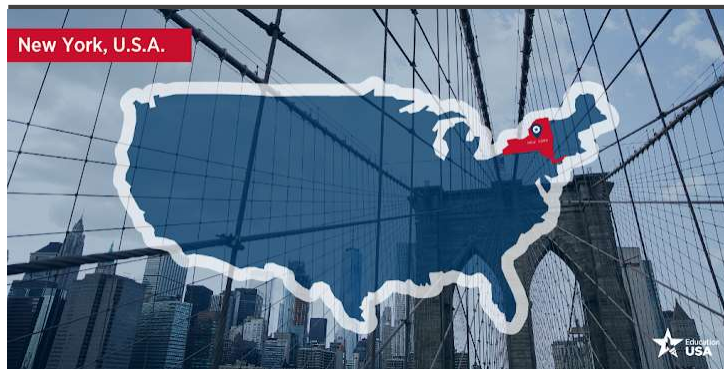

Campus Spotlight: Community Colleges

- Offer 2-year Associate's Degrees
- Many have university transfer agreements, meaning you can take general courses and transfer to a 4-year college or university (the 2+2 model). Students obtain the same bachelor's degrees from their 4-year colleges or universities as they would have if they completed all four years at the 4-year college or university.

 Generally inexpensive. Tuition and fees are less than half that for public 4-year colleges or universities and just a fraction of the cost of attending private 4-year colleges and universities.

 They are "open admission" institutions. This means that rather than turn away students who do not have the prerequisites to take college-level coursework, these colleges are equipped to provide those prerequisites.
