Bence X. Széchenyi is one of the bright and creative young professionals currently in Budapest, Hungary with the honor of receiving a Fulbright Grant. Originally from New York, Bence is a 2020 graduate from Bates College in Maine with an English Literature major. 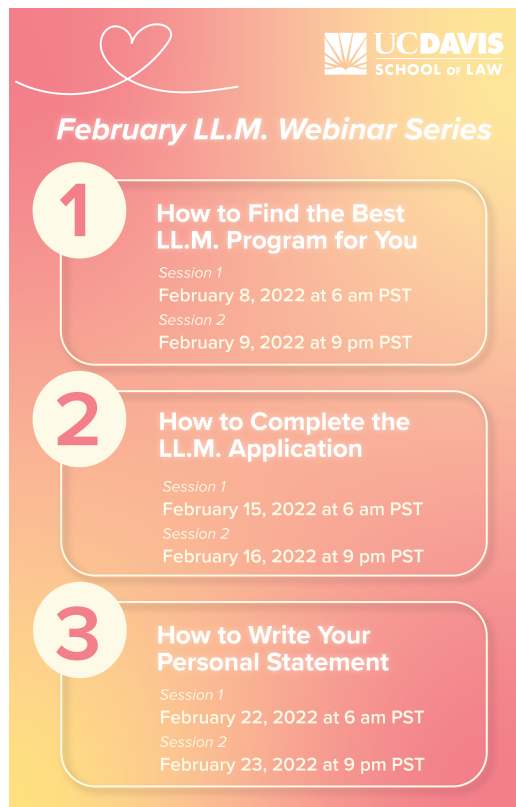
