Are you looking to complete a bachelor's or master's degree in engineering or computer science? Check out the University of Missouri Kansas City School of Science and Engineering's Dean's International Scholar Award!

This renewable award covers a portion of the nonresident tuition rate. As an admitted full-time student, the award is \$8,500 USD per year for bachelor's students and \$8,000 USD per year for master's students.

Looking to save at a public institution? Check out the International Student Scholarship at Sonoma State University!

This \$5,000 USD scholarship is open to new, first-time Sonoma State international undergraduate F-1 visa students (Freshman or transfer students) applying for Fall 2023. Applicants will receive the online IUSS application scholarship after SSU Admissions receives their complete CalStateApply application.
