International Student Application Requirements




Looking for a merit-based scholarship? Check out the New American University Scholarship at Arizona State University!

This scholarship offers up to \$14,500 USD to outstanding incoming international students. Students are considered for this award when they are admitted to ASU. No separate application is required. Eligibility factors include highly competitive GPA and test scores.

All new international undergraduate students are automatically awarded the International Maverick Scholarship, which allows them a savings of more than \$7,000 USD per academic year in tuition.

Looking to offset the cost of an undergraduate degree? Check out the University Center For International Education (UCIE) Undergraduate Merit Scholarship at Wright State University!

This scholarship, ranging from \$6,000 to \$10,000 USD, is automatically considered upon acceptance at Wright State, and based on high school GPA. Eligible students who continue to meet certain criteria can receive this scholarship for a total of eight semesters of full-time undergraduate study.



Looking to transfer institutions and still save? Check out the Transfer Scholarship at Marquette University!

Students from two-year, postsecondary institutions from within the United States or approved institutions outside of the United States, who have completed 24 credits with a 3.2 GPA, are eligible. The scholarship is \$2,000 USD and renewable each semester of a student's four years at Marquette.

Looking to join an honors program and save? Check out the Sesquicentennial Academic **Honors Scholarship at Kutztown University!**

This scholarship, renewable for four years, is equivalent to in-state tuition (approximately \$7,000 USD). Requirements include standardized testing and GPA minimums, completing 30 credits each year, living on campus for their first three years of study, and participating in the KU Honors Program.
