Scholarship/Admission Requirements:

- Academics: We will need grades that are B or better, preferably A's
- Test Scores: We require one test score only of the following: TOEFL iBT 79 or better, IELTS 6.5 or better, SAT (Critical Reading and Math middle 50% range) 1010-1240, ACT (Middle 50% range) 23 - 28
- Common Application: We are a Common Application school, and there is no cost to apply. We also do not require a supplement

- Recommendation Letter: We require only one letter
