Mount Mercy University International Student Scholarships

International students at Mount Mercy University can cover nearly half the cost of attendance with these scholarships. International students can receive academic scholarships, starting at \$10,000 for students with a 2.0 grade average and going up to \$14,500 annually, with no special application required. Students who live on campus can receive an international residential grant of \$3,500. Additional talent and athletic scholarships are also available.

Application deadline: Scholarship consideration is done in conjunction with the regular admission application. Admission deadlines are August 1, 2016 for fall entrance, and January 2, 2016 for spring entrance.
