Northern State University (NSU) is a four-year public university located in Aberdeen, South Dakota, United States. NSU is governed by the South Dakota Board of Regents and offers 38 majors and 42 minors, as well as six associate, eight pre-professional and nine graduate degrees. Northern State University has been ranked among the Top 3 Best Public Colleges in the Midwest, and in the Top 10 Most Affordable in the United States.

The University of Wisconsin Platteville

University of Wisconsin-Platteville (also known as UW-Platteville) is a public university located in Platteville, Wisconsin, United States. Part of the University of Wisconsin System, it offers both bachelor's and master's degrees. The university has three colleges that serve over 8,000 students on-campus and an additional 3,000 students through its five distance education programs.

The University of Wisconsin-Platteville offers 2 scholarships to international undergraduate students. Applicants can apply for both scholarships and may be granted both.

Tuition Remission: Maximum \$5,000 per year (\$2,500 per semester)

Full-time undergraduate degree-seeking international students may apply to receive a tuition remission (scholarship) for up to eight academic semesters, provided that they reapply prior to each semester.

Kathryn Mykel Conger Scholarship: \$500-\$3,000 per year.

Available to new incoming and continuing English Language Program (ELP) and degree-seeking international undergraduate students at UW-Platteville, with priority given to international students pursuing a course of study leading to certification as teachers.

The University of Tulsa

The University of Tulsa (TU) is a private university located in Tulsa, Oklahoma, United States with about 4,300 students.

TU offers a merit-based scholarship based on the student's academic background as well as extracurricular and leadership experience. The award is offered to selected freshmen applicants at the time of admission. Students must submit a completed application for admission with all the required supporting documents. No additional scholarship application is needed and all qualified applicants are automatically considered. Award values vary from \$4,000 to \$14,000 USD. Don't miss out! goo.ql/OxU0iN

The University of South Dakota (or informally USD or the U) is a public coeducational research university located in the small town community of Vermillion, South Dakota. USD was established by the Dakota Territory legislature in 1862, 37 years before the establishment of the state of South Dakota (first classes held 1882 in the Clay County Courthouse),[6] USD is the oldest public university in the state. The University of South Dakota is a big-time university with a friendly, small college feel.
