LL.M Degrees

The LL.M. (Master of Laws) is a one-year postgraduate law degree. Students wishing to pursue an LL.M. degree tend to be interested in specializing in a particular field of law. For example, some popular LL.M. specializations include: international law, tax law,

business law, US law, intellectual property, and human rights. Additionally, the LL.M. degree differs from the JD (Juris Doctor) degree in the US. The JD degree is the first degree in law in the US and is designed to specifically train students to practice law in the US. The JD is not specialized as with the LL.M. and takes three years to complete.

American University Washington College of Law is fully committed to assisting international students in funding their studies in the US. Each of our LL.M. programs offer both **merit-based and need-based scholarship opportunities** to international students. For example, each fall the International Legal Studies LL.M. program offers **5 full scholarships to international applicants**. The S.J.D. program does not currently offer any funding assistance.
