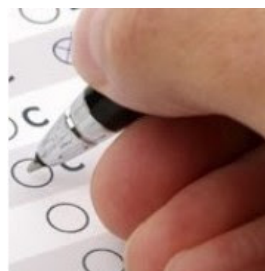

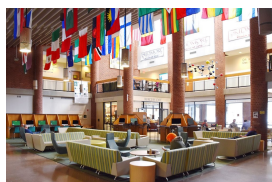

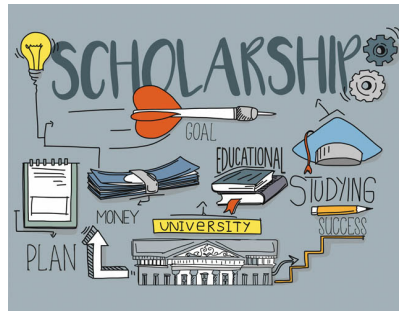
Universities with Financial Aid for International Students
