HAWAII PACIFIC UNIVERSITY MERIT-BASED SCHOLARSHIPS

Hawai'i Pacific University (HPU) is a private, nonprofit university with a student population of approximately 7,000 undergraduate and 1,200 graduate students. HPU is one of the most culturally diverse universities in America with students from all 50 U.S. states and more than 100 countries. Founded in 1965, HPU prides itself on maintaining strong academic programs, small class sizes, individual attention to students, and a diverse faculty and student population.



Hawai'i Pacific University awards a limited number of graduate scholarships each fall and spring semester to new graduate students. These scholarships are available for 2 years, as long as the student is in good standing and maintains a 3.0 GPA. Applicants must apply and be admitted to a Master's program (applicants applying to the 12 Month MBA, Executive MBA, Organizational Change Online or Business Administration Online programs, or the Business Administration Military FlexTrack program are not eligible to apply). Applicants must plan to enroll as a full-time student (minimum 9 credit hours per Fall and Spring semesters).

CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITY-LOS ANGELES INTERNATIONAL STUDENT TUITION WAIVERS





INDIANA UNIVERSITY ANNOUNCES NEW SCHOOL OF GLOBAL AND INTERNATIONAL STUDIES



Indiana University Board of Trustees gave its approval Friday to create a new school of international studies. During the trustees meeting, IU President Michael McRobbie said the new School of Global and International Studies would put the University at the top. The School will combine about 30 programs largely from the college of arts and sciences.

"The new school will enable us to provide all kinds of educational opportunities to our students to our undergraduates, graduate students and provide wonderful opportunities for research," McRobbie says. "And I see it all as being part of the international dimension of Indiana University." The new school will offer a number of bachelor and master's degree tracks as well as doctoral degrees.
