My name is Kasey Golding and I am currently a US Fulbright Research Grantee in Hungary. While I am originally from the sunny state of Florida, I received my Bachelor's Degree in Political Science from the University of Louisville in Kentucky and my Master's Degree in European Studies from KU Leuven in Belgium. Over the past few years, I have spent most of my time living and traveling within Europe—hopping around from the UK to Hungary and everywhere in between.

However, in 2020 my time living in Europe came to an abrupt halt, and like many of you, I had to learn how to adapt to a new normal during the COVID-19 pandemic. Following the end of my stay in Belgium, I made the tough decision to move back home to Florida. Shortly after I arrived home I discovered that my student grant to Hungary had been postponed and I quickly realized that my short gap year was going to be much longer than expected.
