The Global Transfer Scholars award is a competitive, merit-based scholarship awarded to well-qualified transfer international students. This scholarship is renewable for up to two years, or until a first bachelor's degree is earned, whichever comes first. No additional scholarship application is required.

Did you know that there are online tools to help you find scholarships specifically for *you*?

Odds are, if you are looking at studying in the US, the cost of attendance is probably the biggest barrier to making your dream a reality. It can be tricky to figure out how to fund your education abroad, and even harder to know where to start. But, did you know that there are search engines which will allow you to find scholarships that match *you*?

Here's how it works:

1. **Determine what degree you are aiming for.** Are you wanting a two year associate degree, a four year bachelor's degree or a postgraduate degree?
2. **Find scholarships that fit you and your goals.** There are loads of resources available, but we recommend starting with a few trusted search tools. Some good places to start are: the [Institute of International Education](#), [EducationUSA](#), and [International Student](#). You are not alone in the search for funding, and luckily there are plenty of resources to help you along the way.
3. **Apply!** Experts recommend applying for upwards of 100 scholarships before starting your studies. While 100 scholarships isn't always practical, you can utilize resources like EducationUSA's advising center to ensure that you put your best foot forward in the select handful of scholarships you choose to apply to.
