Requirements:

Must be 18 years but not 25 years of age by August 1 the year studies begin.

3. Must be single and not cohabitate in any way for the duration of the scholarship.
4. Must be an undergraduate student.
5. Must meet minimum GPA requirements for the school selected to attend.

Fung Global Scholars Program, Princeton University

The Fung Global Fellows Program, inaugurated in the 2013-14 academic year, reflects **Princeton University's** commitment to engaging with scholars from around the world and inspiring ideas that transcend borders. The program brings exceptional international early-career faculty members working in the social sciences and the humanities to Princeton for a year of research, writing, and collaboration.



Each year, the Fung Global Fellows Program **selects six scholars** from around the world to be in residence at Princeton for one academic year and to engage in research and discussion around a common theme.

Eligibility requirements:

- Scholars who received their PhD.
- Applicants must hold a position outside of the United States.
- Demonstrated outstanding scholarly achievement.
- Scholars who are at the beginning of their careers.
