Lake Forest College Merit-Based Scholarships

Students who demonstrate high-performance on overall school marks/grades as well as standardized test scores may be eligible for up to \$30,000 in renewable scholarship aid. Lake Forest College also offers talent-based scholarships in music, studio art, and theater. Scholarships require an application for admission, the scholarship application, and either an audition for music and theater, or portfolio review for studio art. Scholarships are available to both majors and non-majors.
