## **Scholarship Opportunity: University of Southern Mississippi**

The University of Southern Mississippi, located in Hattiesburg Mississippi near the Gulf Coast of the United States, is pleased to announce new scholarship opportunities for international students and domestic non-residents. Automatic awards are based on merit only and will provide a set amount scholarship for those who meet continuation requirements (3.0/4.0 GPA during their time at USM) for four years. Some awards are based on GPA and SAT or ACT and the International Freshman Scholarship can be awarded without SAT or ACT. Automatic awards range from \$8,000 (the cost of non-resident tuition) to full tuition. Awards requiring SAT are automatically awarded to those meeting the criteria who complete their application by January 5th and the International Freshman Scholarship is awarded automatically throughout the application cycle (until June 1).
