International Student Scholarship at Concordia University

Concordia University is a liberal arts university located in Saint Paul, Minnesota. Concordia University was founded in 1893 and currently enrolls approximately 4,000 students.

Concordia's International Student Scholarship award averages \$8,000 per year for undergraduate students and \$30,000 per year for graduate students. Willamette University MBA Global Diversity Scholarship

Are you thinking about receiving an MBA in the United States? Then check out the Willamette University MBA Global Diversity Scholarship.

This year Willamette MBA has been ranked as a top MBA program in the U.S. by Businessweek, Forbes, CEO Magazine and Poets & Quants and is specifically designed for students who are early in their career (no work experience required) or for those seeking a significant career change.

The Willamette MBA Global Diversity Scholarship program is for international students who completed their bachelor degree in select countries (see link for list of countries). Applicants selected for this scholarship will receive an annual award ranging from \$19,000 to full tuition. Willamette has expanded Global Diversity Scholarship to include more eligible countries and extended the deadline to March 15th!

The goal of the award is to provide financial assistance to international students while allowing them the opportunity to give back at Shippensburg University through interacting with Ship students and other volunteer opportunities.

Florida Eastern European Linkage Program

Qualified students from Eastern European countries who are seeking to study at a Florida State University System institution may receive a waiver award from our Institute which waives the Out-of-State fee portion of their Florida school tuition. This could potentially be a savings of thousands of US dollars per year in tuition/fees. The Institute is hosted by the University of Central Florida, however, students may utilize the award at any Florida public university or Florida state/community college.
