Schools in Focus

Mount Mercy University

Mount Mercy University is a four-year, co-educational Catholic liberal arts university located in Cedar Rapids, Iowa, United States. The school was founded by the Sisters of Mercy in 1928. Mount Mercy has about 1,800 students.

Aquinas College

Aquinas College is a Roman Catholic institution of higher learning located in Nashville, Tennessee founded in 1928 and named in honor of St. Thomas Aquinas. The U.S. News & World Report has ranked Aquinas College as 14th in Best Regional Colleges in the South in its 2015 rankings, up from a ranking of 30th in the previous year. Contributing to the high ranking were the low class sizes and student-to-faculty ratio, high freshman retention rate, high test scores, a high graduation rate, and a high peer assessment score.

University of Findlay

The University of Findlay (UF) is a private university in Findlay, Ohio. It was affiliated with the Churches of God General Conference. Nearly 3,700 students are enrolled at Findlay, with more than 2,700 undergraduate and nearly 1,000 graduate students. UF has been recognized as a “Best in the Midwest” college by the Princeton Review.

Notre Dame de Namur University is a private coeducational Catholic university located in Belmont, California, in the San Francisco Bay Area. It is the third oldest college in California and the first college in the state authorized to grant the baccalaureate degree to women. The university offers bachelor's and master's degrees, certificates and credentials, and has about 1,900 students.
