### Pittsburg State University

Are you interested in playing sports in university or studying physical education? Pittsburg State University, a public four-year university located in Pittsburg, Kansas, boasts competitive volleyball and American football teams. International students from countries as diverse as

The business and arts programs also attract students to Northwest Missouri State.

The university offers all international students two scholarships: an "in-state" tuition discount if the student scores 65 or higher on TOEFL (6.0 IELTS) and merit based awards ranging from \$1000-\$4000, based on the student's SAT score.

programs in computer science and electrical engineering, minimum score of 79 iBT or IELTS score of 6.0 for all other programs. Applications require the GRE.
