University of Minnesota Exchange Semester

Minneapolis,

Minnesota

Spend 1 semester or the full academic year in the U.S. studying alongside U.S. students. Learn from award-winning faculty, earn University of Minnesota credit, and benefit from state-of-the-art learning facilities at one of the nation's top public research universities.

The Minnesota Semester program is open to all students who have completed at least 1 year of university study and who are currently enrolled in an undergraduate degree program outside of the U.S. The exchange requires a TOEFL IBT score of 79 or higher. Learn more here: http://bit.ly/2dwFhEe

Lawrence University

Lawrence University—a small liberal arts ranked 60^{th} in the nation—is home to 2,400 undergraduates, including 184 international students from 50 countries. Located in Appleton, Wisconsin, Lawrence features a range of academic programs and a music conservatory.

The university considers all international students for merit and need-based financial aid, awarding up to full tuition to exceptionally strong candidates. Last year, the average amount of aid awarded to international students was \$22,000, or roughly half the total cost of tuition.

You can contact Admissions Counselor Xue Yan (xue.yan@lawrence.edu) with any questions. Applications require the SAT and must be submitted by January 15th. The university is now accepting applications on its website (http://bit.ly/2cAPTvZ) for Fall 2017 admission.

Mount Mercy University Offers Generous Scholarships

Mount Mercy University, a small liberal arts college in the Midwest, offers academic scholarships of up to \$14,500/annually for international students. No separate application is necessary; applicants are automatically considered based on high school or transfer grades. The University also offers grants to help cover the cost of housing.
