Brandeis meets 100% of demonstrated financial need and provides round-trip airfare for highly accomplished international students who are admitted through the [Wien International Scholarship Program](#). If you graduated from one of the United World Colleges and need financial assistance, you may also be eligible for a large scholarship. The application requires the TOEFL and the SAT or ACT, and operates through the common application system. Deadlines are November 1 for early decision and January 1 for regular decision.
