International Amigo Scholarship

The International Amigo Scholarship entitles qualifying international students to a non-resident tuition waiver (value of more than \$14,000 per year) provided a student meets renewal requirements.

Priority Deadline: January 15, 2015 (not final deadline)

Eligibility

Undergraduates must have:

The equivalent of a U.S. 3.5 upper secondary school (high school) grade point average (GPA) or a 3.25 college GPA (for a student who has completed the equivalent of 30 college credit hours) as determined by UNM or 26 ACT (1190 SAT) and 3.0 Unit GPA

- Admission to a full-time UNM degree program by the deadline
- Non-immigrant visa status (F1 or J1) status
- NO previous attendance in the current UNM program

The Scholarship may be renewed annually for up to four years for freshman applicants and two years for transfer applicants provided the student maintains enrollment in 15 credit hours with a minimum 3.0 GPA each semester. A student who fails to meet the requirements loses the scholarship.
