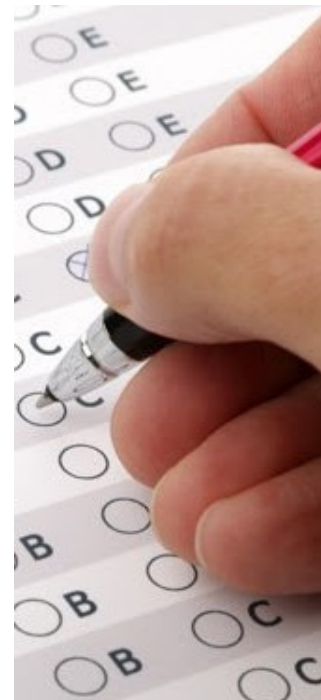

### **Study in Florida and Pay In-State Tuition**

The Florida-Eastern Europe Linkage Institute (EELI) is a program developed by the state of

Florida to encourage ties between Florida and countries in Central and Eastern Europe, including Hungary. Up to 25 students each year who attend a state university in Florida, such as University of Central Florida (see *Schools in Focus*) are eligible to pay the in-state tuition fees (a significantly reduced amount).
