It has been a pleasure! Have a wonderful summer, and don't hesitate to contact EducationUSA if you need anything over the next few months.

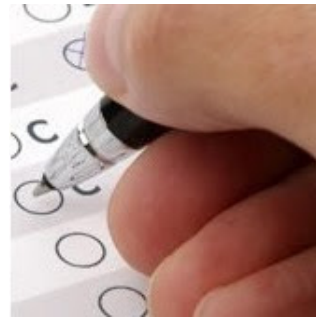
