Statistics refute the notion that "Facebook is a fad, and only relevant in the English-speaking world." The number of Facebook users has increased from 82 million users in July 2008 to over 233 million today, 70 percent of whom are located outside the United States.

As of June, 12 EducationUSA centers had Facebook profiles, 17 centers had Facebook groups and 8 had organization fan pages.
