EASTERN WASHINGTON UNIVERSITY FRESHMAN AND TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIPS

Eastern Washington University is a driving force for the culture, economy and vitality of the Inland Northwest region. The university's beautiful campus, NCAA Division I athletics and opportunities for hands-on, real-world learning provide a classic, yet unique college experience. A focus on personal attention, faculty excellence and community collaboration allows Eastern to accomplish its mission for preparing well-rounded students ready to hit the ground running in their chosen career fields.

Eastern Washington University offers scholarships to freshman and transfer students with a GPA of 3.2 or higher who maintain current F-1 and J-1 visa status. 1+2+1 students must have a minimum TOEFL score of 71 iBT or IELTS score of 6.0 to be eligible. The award amount is \$1,500 - \$4,500 for the academic year, excludes summer session. Recipients must meet 3.5 cumulative GPA to maintain scholarships each quarter and duration.
